
Don't Miss Woodbury's Annual 4th of July Luau!

RULES OF THE POOL: With summer almost here, the pools are getting busier and busier. Please help us keep the community safe by observing and following the pool rules.

1. You MUST have a key fob to enter the pool. Residents without a key will be asked to leave the premises. Please contact the Association at (949) 451-1650 if you have lost your pool key and would like to purchase another one.



- 2. Residents are responsible for letting in their guests into the pool area. There is a limit of (6) guests per household within the pool and park area.
- 3. No smoking of ANY kind, glass, pets, bikes, scooters, loud or disturbing music inside the fenced area.
- 4. Parents MUST be within arms reach of children 6 years or younger while in the pool.
- 5. Due to several emergency situations in the past years, we ask all residents to observe our **No Floatation Device policy**. This includes, but not limited to: arm floatation devices, rafts, inflatable rings, boogie boards, boats, and any other air filled device. Only U.S. Coast Guard approved floatation devices allowed.
- 6. Members may not reserve the pool furniture or cabanas by use of towels or other personal belongings.
- 7. All persons younger than 14 years must be accompanied by an individual 18 years or older. Children under the age of 14 are not allowed in the spa area without an adult.

LIFEGUARDS ON DUTY: Please note that the lifeguards will be on duty at the Lagoon and Resort pool daily, June 9th-August 27th from 12pm-7pm. Please be reminded that the Lifeguards on duty will call safety breaks every hour. All children under the age of 14 years must exit the pool for 10 minutes during the safety break. The safety breaks are a rest period for children to use the restroom and for lifeguards to inspect the pool for any potential hazards. The lifeguards should NOT be considered in lieu of proper parental supervision.

CRIME PREVENTION: Woodbury Homeowners are reminded to take a few steps to keep their home and property safe. During the past year, Woodbury residents have seen an increase in burglaries and thefts including home and vehicle break-ins and a rise in mail theft. The Irvine Police Department highly encourages residents to do the following:

- Get to know your neighbors! Have their phone numbers in case of an emergency.
- Pay attention to surroundings; if something looks suspicious, call and report to Irvine PD (949) 724-7200 or (911)
- Obtain a security system and/or camera system for your home.
- Lock your cars! Lock your windows and doors to your home.

SUMMER MOVIES IN THE PARK: Please join us again this year as we host another season of Movies in the Park! The movies will be


