Facility Key Cards

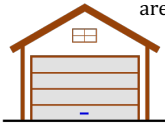

PARKING & GARAGES IN WOODBURY: Woodbury homeowners and residents are reminded of the CC&R restriction regarding Storage of Goods in Garages. Article VIII, Section 11 (d) states, in part: Each Owner shall keep his garage readily available for parking of permitted vehicles and shall not store any goods or material therein, nor use any portion of the garage for storage or other use if such storage would prevent Owner from parking the number of vehicles therein for which said garage was originally designed and constructed. Please make sure you are utilizing your home's garage space for the intended number of vehicles. Parking along most of the Woodbury streets are on City of Irvine streets. Some streets are private Woodbury streets. Please make yourself aware of street parking restrictions in Woodbury. You may contact the General Manager with any questions at (949) 451-1654.
