RULES OF THE POOL: With summer almost here, the pools are getting busier and busier. Please help us keep the community safe by observing and following the pool rules. *Please note that the lifeguards will be on duty at the Lagoon and Resort pool daily beginning June 7th – August 22nd from 12 p.m. to 7 p.m.*

- 1. You MUST have a key card to enter the pool. Residents without a key card will be asked to leave the premises. Please contact the Association at (949) 451-1650 if you have lost your pool key card and would like to purchase another one.
- 2. Residents are responsible for letting in their guests into the pool area. There is a limit of (6) guests per household within the pool and park area.
- 3. No smoking of ANY kind, glass, pets, bikes, scooters, loud or disturbing music inside the fenced area.
- 4. Parents MUST be within arms reach of children 6 years of younger while in the pool.
- 5. Due to several emergency situations in the past years, we ask all residents to observe our <u>No Floatation Device</u> <u>Policy</u>. This includes, but not limited to: arm floatation devices, rafts, inflatable rings, boogie boards, boats, and any other air filled device. Only U.S. Coast Guard approved floatation devices allowed.
- 6. Members may not reserve the pool furniture or cabanas by use of towels or other personal belongings.
- 7. All persons younger than 14 years of age must be accompanied by an individuals 18 years or older. Children under the age of 14 are not allowed in the spa without an adult.

You are responsible for your tenants!

- This means you need to provide them with and make sure they are aware that there are Rules and Regulations & CC&R's.
- If they are violating any of the CC&R's or Rules and Regulations, you will receive a violation letter and your tenant will be mailed a copy. If the violation is escalated to a hearing, you will be asked to attend the hearing to discuss the issue with the Board of Directors.

You automatically delegate the use of the recreational amenities to your tenants for the duration of their tenancy and your rights to use and enjoy the Master Association Property, and the recreational amenities are suspended. This means that you will not have access to use the pools/basketball courts/tennis courts or be able to reserve the clubhouse for an event or attend Community events. (see Section 4 of the CC&R's).
