All pool heaters were shut off on October 31st except the Lagoon pool and the Competition pool. The Lagoon pool will be open from 6 am – 10 pm Sunday through Thursday and 6 am – 11 pm on Friday and Saturday. The Competition pool hours are 5:30 am – 10 pm Sunday through Thursday and 5:30 am – 11 pm Friday and Saturday. Additionally, the Jacuzzi's will remain open throughout winter. **Please remember swim diapers for the children swimming to avoid unnecessary pool/Jacuzzi closers.**
