SWIM LESSONS AT WOODBURY: Please note that ALL swim lessons in the Woodbury Community MUST be taught only by our approved vendors. If you see anyone receiving lessons at any of the pools other than at the Recreation Center, please contact Management immediately. You must be approved in order to give lessons, because it protects the Association from any potential lawsuits. The "Association's approved swimming instructor" includes someone that has entered into a license agreement with the Association and has provided the necessary insurance and indemnity required by the Association. DOG POOP: Please note that all residents are responsible for picking up after their pets. Please help us in keeping the

STREET LIGHT OUTAGE: Please note that the Association does not maintain streetlights. If you notice a streetlight that is out, flickering, or damaged you will need to contact Southern California Edison. You can visit their website at www.sce.com or you can use a search engine and type: Southern California light outage and it will direct you to the right place to submit a work order. Make sure you have the pole number ready to submit (located on every streetlight).

STORED VEHICLES: Residents are not allowed to store vehicles within Woodbury Community. Vehicles that appear to be stored will be marked and towed.

STREET SWEEPING DAYS: Street sweeping days are on the 2^{nd} and 4^{th} Friday of each month. Please make sure your vehicles are not parked on the street on those days.
