Community Updates

Community Reminders:

- 1. No smoking, of any kind, allowed inside the pool areas. If you need to smoke, please go outside the pool area away from the entrance. Smoking of any kind, including, but not limited to, cigarettes, cigars, pipes, e-cigarettes, vapor pens, vapor pipes, hookahs, is prohibited.
- 2. Per the Association's CC&R's, "Each homeowner shall be responsible for cleaning up excrement or other unclean or unsanitary condition caused by their animal(s) anywhere in the community. All animals must be kept within an appropriate enclosed, yard or patio, or on a leash held by a person capable of controlling the animal."
- 3. In an effort to save water, please make sure you are turning off the showers in all of the pool areas when you are finished.
- 4. Stored Vehicles: A vehicle will be deemed stored when it has not shown "substantial" movement for any 96-hour period. A substantial movement involves the removal of the community for at least an 8-hour period and parking in a different parking space.
- 5. Fire Lane Parking: Vehicles parked in a marked fire lane or within 15 feet of a fire hydrant are subject to immediate towing at the owner's expense.
