RULES OF THE POOL

With summer almost here, the pools are getting busier and busier. Please help us keep the community safe by observing and following the pool rules.

- 1. You MUST have a key fob to enter the pool. Residents without a key will be asked to leave the premises. Please contact the Association at (949) 451-1650 if you have lost your pool key and would like to purchase another one.
- 2. Residents are responsible for letting in their guests into the pool area.
- 3. Residents must be with their guest(s) at all times.
- 4. No smoking of ANY kind, glass, pets, bikes, scooters, loud or disturbing music inside the fenced area.
- 5. Parents MUST be within arms reach of children 6 years or younger while in the pool.
- 6. Due to several emergency situations last year, we ask all residents to observe our No Floatation Device policy. This includes, but not limited to: arm floatation devices, rafts, inflatable rings, boogie boards, boats, and any other air filled device. This helps our lifeguards keep an eye on your children as well as promoting your child's safety. Only U.S. Coast Guard approved flotation devices allowed.
- 7. There is a limit of (6) guests per household within the pool and park area.
- 8. Members may not reserve the pool furniture or cabanas by use of towels or other personal belongings.
- 9. Children not toilet trained must wear swim diapers. Members may be fined \$300 for pool closures due to defecation in pools.

LIFEGUARDS ON DUTY!

We are pleased to announce that Safe Swim will be providing Lifeguard service, instead of Pool Monitor service, to our community this summer.



Please note that the lifeguards will be on duty at the Lagoon and Resort pool daily starting June 23rd-September 1st from 12pm-7pm.

Please be reminded that the Lifeguards on duty will call safety breaks every hour. All children under the age of 14 years must exit the pool for 10 minutes during the safety break. The safety breaks are a rest period for children to use the restroom and for lifeguards to inspect the pool for any potential hazards.

The lifeguards should NOT be considered in lieu of proper parental supervision. All persons younger than 14 years must be accompanied by an individual 18 years or older. Children under the age of 14 are not allowed in the spa area without an adult.

COMMUNITY REMINDERS:

PET WASTE: Please note that all residents are responsible for picking up after their pets. Please have courtesy for your neighbors by not allowing your animals to pee/defecate on other's front yards, or in the common area.

TRASH CANS: As a reminder, per the Association's CC&Rs, trash containers must be stored completely out of view from the street, except for twelve hours before and after the scheduled pick up time. Please kindly have your trash cans stored out of view in the future, unless it is during the designated times.
