Ride Height Requirements

Kids Carousel – 100 lbs maximum; 36" tall min to ride alone

Giant Slide - At least 42" to ride

Ferris Wheel – Must be 48" to ride alone

Large Swing - Minimum of 42" to ride

Ride restrictions will be strictly enforced.

Important Community Update:

Recently, the Woodbury Community Association Board of Directors conducted a search for new property management companies in order to do their fiduciary duty of insuring your Community was receiving the best service level and value possible. After serious consideration, the Board voted to terminate Professional Community Management and engage Keystone Pacific Property Management as of November 1, 2014. Please look for information in the mail from Keystone Pacific that will give you valuable information on how to set up auto-pay for your monthly assessments as well as who to contact for accounting questions. All on site office phone numbers will remain the same and only the email addresses will change for the General Manager, Susan Seifen and the Recreation Director, Kayla Stephenson. Please make sure to sign up on the Woodbury website for e-news updates so you can receive up to date information.

Community Reminders:

STREET SWEEPING DAYS: Please note that street sweeping days are on the 2nd and 4th Friday of each month. Please make sure your vehicles are not parked on the street on those days.

STREET LIGHT OUTAGE: Please note that the Association does not maintain streetlights. If you notice a streetlight that is out, flickering, or damaged you will need to contact Southern California Edison. You can visit their website at www.sce.com or you can use a search engine and type: Southern California light outage and it will direct you to the right place to submit a work order. Make sure you have the pole number ready to submit (located on every streetlight) and a nearby address.

SMOKING AT PARKS & POOLS: No smoking, of any kind, is allowed inside the pool areas and at the parks in Woodbury. If you need to smoke, please go outside the pool area away from the entrance. Smoking of any kind, including, but not limited to, cigarettes, cigars, pipes, e-cigarettes, vapor pens, vapor pipes, hookahs, is prohibited.

DOG POOP: Please note that all residents are responsible for picking up after their pets. Please help us in keeping the community clean by remembering to bring a doggie bag and picking up after your animals' excrement's.

BARKING DOGS: Please note that any concerns you have regarding a barking dog or dogs without a leash, please contact Animal Control at (949) 724-7092.

STORED CARS: A vehicle will be deemed stored when it has not shown "substantial" movement for any 72-hour period. A substantial movement involves the removal of the community for at least an 8-hour period and parking in a different parking space.

SHOWERS AT THE POOLS: In an effort to save water, please make sure you are turning off the showers in all of the pool areas and limit use to 3 minutes when you are finished.
