Community Reminders:

- 1. **Smoking:** No smoking, of any kind, allowed inside the pool areas. If you need to smoke, please go outside the pool area away from the entrance. Smoking of any kind, including, but not limited to, cigarettes, cigars, pipes, e-cigarettes, vapor pens, vapor pipes, hookahs, is prohibited.
- 2. **Street Parking in Woodbury:** If you note a stored vehicle on a street, you may contact Irvine PD at (949) 724-7200 to tag the vehicle for storage and possible removal. If the street is private, they will direct you to the Association. As a reminder, your garage is meant to park vehicles, not for storage. Help us keep our streets open and safe by parking in your garage.
- 3. **Showers:** In an effort to save water, please make sure you are turning off the showers in all of the pool areas when you are finished.
- 4. **Stored Vehicles:** A vehicle will be deemed stored when it has not shown "substantial" movement for any 96-hour period. A substantial movement involves the removal of the community for at least an 8-hour period and parking in a different parking space.
- 5. **Dog Poop:** Please note that all residents are responsible for picking up after their pets. Please help us in keeping the community clean by remembering to bring a doggie bag and picking up after your animals' excrement's and disposing of the bag in a trash can, not in the grass or shrubs.
