

#### MAIL THEFT AND HOW WE CAN PROTECT OURSELVES

Unfortunately mail and package theft has become an issue in the Orange County area, especially in nicer areas such as Woodbury. Management works closely with Irvine PD in monitoring the neighborhood, but it only takes a brief moment for a thief to grab a package from a door step or take someone's mail, making it a difficult matter to regulate. In an effort to keep our residents informed we are offering the following suggestions, provided by the Irvine Police Department, in response to recent mail thefts.

- Always deposit your mail inside your local post office, or hand it to your letter carrier.
- Have your local post office hold your mail while you're on vacation, or absent from your home for a long period of time.
- If you don't receive a check or other valuable mail you're expecting, contact the issuing agency immediately.
- If a package is being delivered without a signature required, make sure someone will be home to receive the package or have packages delivered to a secure P.O. Box location.

Although most of the mailboxes in Woodbury are maintained by the Association and cannot be altered, there are locking mailbox inserts that can be purchased online, which can easily be installed inside your mailbox for your protection. The locking insert can be purchased through Streetscape Inc. at (714) 898-4842. Please note if you do choose to purchase an insert, you would be responsible for its maintenance, any damage to the mailbox structure and for providing any new owner of your home the keys. If you observe what appears to be a theft in progress immediately call Irvine PD dispatch at (949) 724-7200.

#### NEW MANAGEMENT COMPANY:

As you know, Keystone Pacific Property Management has been the managing agent for the Woodbury Community Association since November 1, 2014. It has come to our attention over the last couple of months that some homeowners are still unaware that the change happened and are having their banks still send payments to PCM. Please be advised that you need to change the mailing address with your bank so payments come to Keystone Pacific instead of PCM. If you are interested in setting up auto debit so Keystone deducts your monthly assessments from your checking or savings account each month, please contact the General Manager at <a href="mailto:seeifen@keystonepacific.com">seeifen@keystonepacific.com</a> and she will email an ACH form to you.

#### STREET PARKING IN WOODBURY:

If you note a stored vehicle on a street, you may contact Irvine PD at (949) 724-7200 to tag the vehicle for storage and possible removal. If the street is private, they will direct you to the Association. As a reminder, your garage is meant to park vehicles, not for storage. Help us keep our streets open and safe by parking in your garage.

#### DOG POOP:

Please note that all residents are responsible for picking up after their pets. Please help us in keeping the community clean by remembering to bring a doggie bag and picking up after your animals' excrement's and disposing of the bag in a trash can, not in the grass or shrubs.
