Join us at the Recreation Center on **Saturday, March 31 from 1 - 4 p.m.**, in the Revival parking lot and Great Lawn area for a fun filled afternoon! There will be many great activities, including pony rides, a petting zoo, rides, jumpers, balloon artists and the return of our beloved Easter Egg Hunt. All rides, including the pony ride, accommodate a maximum weight of 75 pounds. In addition, the swing ride requires children be at least 36 inches tall.



HOMEOWNERS: PLEASE REPORT STREET LIGHTS NEEDING SERVICE

Have you noticed a street light that has been out for some time, or flickering on and off? Let us know and we will contact Southern California Edison to place a work order. Edison does not conduct light inspections for the communities they service, so we rely on our vendors and homeowners who are here at night to let us know if a street light requires service.

You can either place a request directly with SCE at www.sce.com, or email management with your request at jmazzotti@pcminternet.com. All we need is the location of the light and the pole number. The pole number can be found approximately five feet up on the side of the pole on silver metal plates, typically ending in an "E".

WOODBURY OFFERS YEAR AROUND SWIM AND TENNIS LESSONS FOR WOODBURY RESIDENTS

With many new owners this year in the community, we would like to remind residents that private swim and tennis lessons are strictly prohibited within the facilities of Woodbury, unless you are using one of the vendors approved and insured with the association.

Due to liability reasons, this is strictly enforced. Although signs are posted at each facility, we continue to have residents conducting private lessons for their families, including professional instruction for extended family and/or friends. The association staff and patrol service have been advised to check identification for instructors showing proof of employment with our approved vendors. If an instructor does not have proof of employment with one of the companies below, they will be asked to exit the facility immediately.

It is our sincere desire to avoid this happening and we appreciate residents utilizing one of the companies below, if you are interested in either swim or tennis lessons. COMMUNITY REMINDERS

Let's work together to maintain this beautiful community! Please follow these community policies:

Clean up after your pets! There are doggie bag stations at each park for your convenience.

PAINTING SPECIALS FOR WOODBURY RESIDENTS

As the community matures, homes begin to require additional maintenance needs. Typically wood trim, shutters, garage doors, etc. need to be painted every three to four years to maintain longevity and overall appearance. The management team for Woodbury has worked with First Street Painting to put together special pricing for our residents. First Street Painting is a licensed and insured contractor that has been successfully servicing the homeowner association industry for over 20 years. They have put together similar programs for surrounding communities to help associations and homeowners work together in maintaining the overall appearance of the communities they serve.

If you are living in a single family home and are responsible for the maintenance of your home, please take a moment to look at the exterior. If there are severely faded or peeling areas of paint, please make arrangements to have the areas painted.

We hope by offering assistance in having a contractor like First Street Painting available to our residents, it will help in expediting the completion of these needed repairs. You can contact First Street Painting at (714) 692-8702, or any other contractor of your choice to take care of your exterior painting. Again this program is being offered only to assist residents in finding a contractor. You are not obligated to use First Street Painting, nor is the association responsible for any workmanship preformed by First Street, or payment to them for this work.

CHECK THE WINTER POOL & SPA HEATING SCHEDULE

Just a reminder, the heat to the pools and waders at Peppertree Square, Cypress Square, Promenade Square, Date Palm Square and the Resort pool at the Recreation Center has been turned off for the winter. The heat is scheduled to be turned back on at the beginning of April for all of these facilities.

The heat for the Lagoon Pool and the Competition Pool is on year around, along with all spas at each facility. However, the umbrellas and cabana tops at each pool facility have been put away for the season to prevent damage during high wind conditions. They will be put back out in the pool areas at the beginning of April as well.

Please note that the Association will be conducting needed repairs at the pool facilities throughout the winter months. The website will be updated with pool closure information, and management will "e-blast" residents with exact dates and locations when information is available. We appreciate your patience while the Association completes these needed repairs.
