ENJOYING THE POOLS MEANS FOLLOWING THE RULES

We hope you are enjoying the beginning of summer! Woodbury is a wonderful community, with beautiful amenities unlike anywhere in Orange County. To keep our pools safe and enjoyable for all Woodbury residents and their guests, we'd like to remind residents of the rules to follow while using any of our seven pool facilities. The rules below are only a few of the more common issues we have at the pools. Residents are responsible for ensuring they are aware of all the Rules and Regulations for our facilities and informing their guests as well. If you are not sure of the rules and would like a full copy, you may obtain one at our website at www.woodburyhoa.org.

All guests using the pool must be accompanied by a resident. If you have guests coming to visit you and you are already in the pool, you will be responsible for coming to the gate to let your guest in. Staff will not allow quests in to the facilities without a resident present.

Residents must have their keys to obtain access to the facility and will not be let in without a key. You may be asked to show your key to verify your membership. Failure to show your key to any managing agent or a vendor hired by the association, such as the patrol service or pool monitor, may result in immediate removal from the gated area.

Members are allowed a maximum of six (6) guests per household in any of the pool areas. Large parties of more than six guests in addition to members of your household are not allowed and will be asked to leave the pool areas. Small children with limited swimming abilities must be under direct supervision of an adult in the pool with that child at all times.

Children that are not toilet trained must have a swim diaper on at all times. There is no glass allowed in the pool areas at any time. You may be asked to open your coolers for glass inspections. This is strictly for the safety of our residents and we appreciate your assistance in complying with this request when asked by a member of the staff.

Pool furniture or eating areas within the pools cannot be reserved with towels. Items left unattended and left for the intent of "saving spaces" for later parties, will be removed.

There are no private swim lessons allowed within the pools at Woodbury. Swim lessons can only be provided with an instructor contracted and insured with the Association. If you are found to be giving or receiving swim lessons in one of the Woodbury pools with an instructor not approved with the Association, you will be asked to cease those lessons immediately. Bicycles, razors, skateboard or other wheeled equipment are not allowed in the pool areas or courtyard at the Lagoon pool. There are areas for you to lock up your bikes outside the pool areas. Please bring a proper lock so you can lock up your bike when using recreation facilities.

The Association reserves the right to request that an individual leave our facilities at any time for not complying with the rules established for these areas. We sincerely hope to avoid these types of altercations and wish you a fun and safe summer here at Woodbury!
