## PROTECTING YOUR HOLIDAY PACKAGES

The holiday season is right around the corner! During the holidays, thieves will follow delivery trucks, stealing the packages that the driver leaves at peoples' front doors. Thieves will case neighborhoods, stealing the unattended packages. Here are a few tips on how to protect your packages from theft:

- Get a tracking number from the shipping company.
- Require a signature with delivery.
- Have the company leave the package at a local shipping center if you won't be home.
- If you can't retrieve it daily, have a trusted person get it.
- Never leave packages outside your door.
- If you're traveling, have the post office hold your mail until you get back.
- Insure any packages you send.
- Alert recipients of your packages as to when they are to expect them.

#### WINTER POOL & SPA HEATING SCHEDULE

Just a reminder, the heat to the pools and waders at Cypress Square, Peppertree Square, and Date Palm Square have been turned off for the winter. The heat will be turned back on again beginning April 1st for all of these areas. The heat for the Lagoon pool, Competition pool, Promenade Square (turns off 12/1), Resort pool, wader and spa at the Recreation Center, as well as all of the spas throughout the community, are scheduled to be on throughout winter, unless closed for repairs.

## **PETS OFF LEASH**

Management has received an increase in calls regarding dogs off-leash within the Woodbury Community. According to the City's Municipal Code: No person owning or having charge, care or custody of any dog shall cause, fail to curb, or allow the same to run at large upon any highway, street, alley, sidewalk, schoolyard, common area, trail, open space or other public place, or upon any private property or premises other than his or her own without written consent of the owner or leasee of such land, unless such dog is restrained by a substantial leash, not to exceed six feet in length, and in the charge of a person competent to restrain such dog. This section does not apply to an approved dog park where it is authorized to run your dog(s) off leash, nor does it apply to those situations enumerated under Section 4-5-707 of this chapter. Dogs can run off-leash at Central Bark Dog Park located at 6405 Oak Canyon in Irvine. Thank you for helping keep all pets safe!
