- Suspect that a home is being used for Airbnb? Contact Irvine Code Enforcement for the City Irvine at (949) 724-6326.
- 4. Facility Room Rentals & Park Rentals? Key Card assistance? Contact the Recreation Director at (949) 451-1650.
- Suspicious people and happenings in the neighborhood? Contact the Irvine Police Department at (949) 724-7200.
- Questions or concerns about any of the parks, pools or common area landscaping? Contact the General Manager at (949) 451-1654.

Please note: If you live in a condo association, you will need to contact the manager for your condo association regarding any issues with your building or landscaping around your home. If you are in a single-family home, you will need to contact the appropriate type of vendor for assistance.

IF YOU RENT YOUR HOME....WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

You are responsible for your tenants!

- This means you need to provide them with and make sure they are aware that there are Rules and Regulations & CC&R's.
- If they are violating any of the CC&R's or Rules and Regulations, you will receive a violation letter and your tenant will be mailed a copy. If the violation is escalated to a hearing, you will be asked to attend the hearing to discuss the issue with the Board of Directors.

You automatically delegate the use of the recreational amenities to your tenants for the duration of their tenancy and your rights to use and enjoy the Master Association Property, and the recreational amenities are suspended. This means that you will not have access to use the pools/basketball courts/tennis courts or be able to reserve the clubhouse for an event or attend Community events. (see Section 4 of the CC&R's).

BOARD OF DIRECTORS CORNER:





- Reminder: More and more cars are parking on Woodbury streets, which might indicate that residents are not using their garages for their vehicles. <u>Violations of CC&R's do carry a fine!</u> Woodbury homeowners and residents are reminded of the CC&R restriction regarding Storage of Goods in Garages. Article VIII, Section 11 (d) states, in part: Each owner shall keep his garage readily available for parking of permitted vehicles and shall not store any goods of material therein, nor use any portion of the garage for storage or other use if such storage would prevent Owner from parking the number of vehicles therein for which said garage was originally designed and constructed.
- Please do not liter in our beautiful community. Let's all work together to keep our Woodbury Community looking its best. There has been an increase in individuals tossing their containers and/or trash in the lawn and streets.
- REQUEST: Parents: If your child skateboards, scooters, and/or rides a bike, please remind them of the safety requirements when using such equipment. We want everyone in the Woodbury Community to have a safe and happy fun filled summer!
