PROTECTING YOUR HOLIDAY PACKAGES: The holiday season is right around the corner! During the holidays, thieves will follow delivery trucks, stealing packages that the driver leaves at peoples' front doors. Thieves will case neighborhoods, stealing unattended packages. Here are a few tips on how to protect your packages from theft:

- Get a tracking number from the shipping company.
- Require a signature with delivery.
- Have the company leave the package at a local shipping center if you won't be home.
- If you can't retrieve it daily, have a trusted person get it.
- Never leave packages outside your door.
- If you're traveling, have the post office hold your mail until you get back.
- Insure any packages you send.
- Alert recipients of your packages as to when they are to expect them.

BULKY ITEM DISPOSAL:

Residents may request bulk item pickup service for items that are just too big to fit in your household curbside collection cart. Requesting this service online is easy by going to http://www.wm.com/us/residential, or by calling (800) 596-7444. Items must be placed on the curb for removal. Additional charges may apply.

IF YOU RENT YOUR HOME....WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: ←←←←←←← You are responsible for your tenants!

- This means you need to provide them with and make sure they are aware that there are Rules and Regulations & CC&R's.
- If they are violating any of the CC&R's or Rules and Regulations, you will receive a violation letter and your tenant will be mailed a copy. If the violation is escalated to a hearing, you will be asked to attend the hearing to discuss the issue with the Board of Directors.

You automatically delegate the use of the recreational amenities to your tenants for the duration of their tenancy and your rights to use and enjoy the Master Association Property, and the recreational amenities are suspended. This means that you will not have access to use the pools/basketball courts/tennis courts or be able to reserve the clubhouse for an event or attend Community events. (see Section 4 of the CC&R's).









BOARD OF DIRECTORS CORNER:

CLUSTER MAILBOXES - SINGLE FAMILY HOMES ONLY:

Due to the increase in mailbox theft in the single-family homes that have the curbside mailboxes, the Board of Directors approved to have cluster mailbox units installed. Certain streets have already been completed and the rest of the single-family homes will be done in phases. Please keep an eye out for a letter from the Association that will indicate when you can pick up your new mailbox keys. Please note that the post office representative took into consideration the location of where the cluster units will be installed by making sure none were in front of any homes.

Please keep in mind that if the boxes are not right by your house, that the reason the boxes are the way they are is to keep streets together. When routes are designed, the post office tries to keep one carrier in a certain area, depending on the routes, line of travel and the amount of deliveries so they don't have to break certain tracks between two routes. Please make sure to pick up your new mailbox keys so you can pick up your mail when the curbside boxes are removed.
