#### **REPLACEMENT MAILBOX KEYS:**

If you lose your mailbox keys and you're in a single-family home, you will need to contact the United States Postal Service on 1 League in Irvine. The cost for a replacement lock is \$50.00 and it will take 2-3 days to go through the whole process. You will fill out a form at the USPS, present a photo ID, and a current utility bill. #### **DOGGIE BAG STATIONS:**

Management has noticed an increase of the doggie bag station trash cans being used for personal trash instead of for dog waste. We have found trash from people's homes, food, and more. Please kindly use these stations for what they were intended for, which is dog waste.








Over the past couple of weeks, we have continued to have technical issues with the AppointmentPlus & Bookly system on the Woodbury website and have not had the support we needed from them to have those issues resolved.



You will need to create a new account through the TennisBookings.com system and then you can begin booking reservations. You should see the Woodbury logo on the top left of the page, and that is how you know you're in the right place.

Residents will now also be able to cancel their reservations, which we know was a feature wasn't previously offered.
