Cookie Decorating for kids Date: June 12



Board & Brush Painting Date: June 26





IF YOU RENT YOUR HOME – WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: You are responsible for your tenants! You automatically delegate the use of the recreational amenities to your tenants for the duration of your tenancy and your rights to use and enjoy the Master Association Property, and the recreational amenities are suspended. This means that you will not have access to use the pools and/or sport courts or to be able to reserve the clubhouse for an event or attend the Community events. (see Section 4 of the CC&R's)

- You will need to provide your tenants with the Rules and Regulations & CC&R's.
- If they are violation any of the CC&R's or Rules and Regulations, you will receive a violation letter and your tenant will be mailed a copy. If the violation is escalated to a hearing, you will be asked to attend the hearing to discuss the issue with the Board of Directors.

Each new tenant will need to get new key cards with their own family photo on them. They may not use key cards that do not have their photo on it. Homeowners will need to notify the General Manager or Recreation Director regarding any new tenants so that we may update the current Key Card Application on file. WANT TO KNOW WHAT'S GOING ON IN THE COMMUNITY?

Woodbury residents can stay informed by going to the Woodbury website where you can find information such as agendas for upcoming meetings, minutes from past board meetings, newsletters, events, contact information, amenity updates, facility and park rental information, and much more! The Board of Directors has made the decision to withdraw their application with the City of Irvine to relocate the sand volleyball court. The volleyball court will stay at the resort pool area and the Board will be looking into adding a rinse off station and possible wall around the court. Since the application has been withdrawn with the City of Irvine, the public hearing will not be necessary.

FACILITY & PARK RESERVATIONS:

The Woodbury Clubroom & Courtyard and parks are now available for reservations. All applications, fees and deposit, and insurance must be submitted to the Woodbury office at 108 Lamplighter. Rentals are first come first serve. We will not hold any dates unless we have the contract, check with the fees and deposit, copy of a photo ID, and a current utility bill submitted to our office. REPLACEMENT MAILBOX KEYS: If you lose your mailbox keys and you're in a single-family home, you will need to contact the United States Postal Service on 1 League in Irvine. The cost for a replacement lock is \$50.00 and it will take 2-3 days to go through the whole process. You will fill out a form at the USPS, present a photo ID, and a current utility bill. If you have any questions, you can call the post office at (714) 368-3374.

ADDRESS VISIBILITY: Please take a look at the front of your home for the visibility of your house number. Many addresses are missing completely or are being blocked by overgrown shrubs or trees.

PETS ON LEASH: Please be reminded to keep your pets on a leash at all times during walks in Woodbury.

TRESPASSING: Please be respectful of your neighbor's property by not walking on their front lawn or allowing your pets to do so. Thank you for your cooperation.



BOARD OF DIRECTORS CORNER:

Attention Woodbury Homeowners & Residents: The Board of Directors wants to bring attention to every resident in our Woodbury Community the ongoing issue we are having with street parking. This major issue has been discussed in several past issues of our bi-monthly newsletter. Over the past several years, there has been a huge increase in street parking throughout our community. We recognize that as our children have grown and are now driving that means families now have more than 2 drivers and possibly more than two cars per address.



Therefore, it is very important that if you have a 2-car garage that 2 of your vehicles are parked in the garage and not in the street.

As a result of this parking crisis, we have asked the respected sub-association managers to address this issue with each of their residents and conduct garage inspections. We want to ensure that the 1 or 2 car garages are not being used for storage/workout rooms (gyms)/playrooms for the kids, etc.



We have also asked each sub-association manager to report back to us, identifying what steps each of them is taking within their community in Woodbury to ensure that their residents are using their garage for parking of their vehicles.



If the street parking issue is **NOT RESOLVED**, the Woodbury Board is looking into the possibility of implementing a parking permit program in which residents would be required to obtain a permit if they wish to park on the street. If such a program is initiated, there would be a monthly cost to residents to maintain.
