LETTERS FROM THE ASSOCIATION:

Management will conduct weekly property inspections, and while onsite we will generate letters to homeowners for violations we notice. These letters may require you to repaint areas on your property or correct a CC&R violation. Here are some helpful tips in dealing with these friendly reminders.



- Don't get upset. No one likes to receive these letters, but remember a courtesy letter is just that, a courtesy. From time to time, a friendly reminder is sent to you letting you know that an item needs to be addressed.
- Correct violations before they happen. Put away your trash can or mow your lawn weekly. Keep your neighborhood looking good. This helps protect your property values.
- Don't ignore the Association's request. Homeowners are sent a courtesy notice, if the violation continues, then they will be called to a Hearing before the Board of Directors. Correct violations immediately and/or call your Manager to discuss.

Attention Woodbury Homeowners & Residents: The Board of Directors wants to bring attention to every resident in our Woodbury Community the ongoing issue we are having with street parking. This major issue has been discussed in several past issues of our bi-monthly newsletter. Over the past several years, there has been a huge increase in street parking throughout our community. We recognize that as our children have grown and are now driving that means families now have more than 2 drivers and possibly more than two cars per address.

As a result of this parking crisis, we have asked the respected sub-association managers to address this issue with each of their residents and conduct garage inspections. We want to ensure that the 1 or 2 car garages are not being used for storage/workout rooms (gyms)/playrooms for the kids, etc.

We have also asked each sub-association manager to report back to us, identifying what steps each of them is taking within their community in Woodbury to ensure that their residents are using their garage for parking of their vehicles. If the street parking issue is **NOT RESOLVED**, the Woodbury Board is looking into the possibility of implementing a parking permit program in which residents would be required to obtain a permit if they wish to park on the street. If such a program is initiated, there would be a monthly cost to residents to maintain.

- <u>Safety Reminder:</u> Drive responsibly. Woodbury has stop signs and speed limits for everyone's safety! Please observe and pay attention. This also applies to those on bikes and scooters. More importantly, please do not skateboard behind electric bikes or cars! Safety for the community is our main concern.
- **Reminder:** Let's keep our community looking pristine! Please do not litter! It appears folks are too lazy to dispose of candy wrappers and bottles/cups properly by using the trash cans that are placed throughout the community. Any extra efforts that we have to employ costs the Association money.

SHORT TERM RENTALS:

Did you know that both Woodbury and the City of Irvine do NOT allow short-term rentals?

Q: WHAT IS A SHORT-TERM RENTAL?

A: A short-term rental is a dwelling unit rented out to occupants for fewer than 31 consecutive days.

O: AM I ALLOWED TO OPERATE A SHORT-TERM RENTAL?

A: Short-term rentals are prohibited in all residential zones. As outlined in City of Irvine Zoning Section 3-25-3.A(link is external), "no responsible party shall operate or allow the operation of a short-term rental in any residential zoning district within the City."

O: WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I BELIEVE MY NEIGHBOR IS USING THE HOME AS A SHORT-TERM RENTAL?

A: If you believe a short-term rental is operating in your neighborhood, please contact the Short-Term Rental Hotline at 949-269-3600. The hotline is available 24 hours a day and seven days a week.
